Wood Vue, Spennymoor

Working to reduce the risk of flooding in your area

Works Description

Northumbrian Water are investing £800k to upgrade the sewers in Spennymoor to reduce the risk of sewer flooding on Durham Road. Works will include upsizing the existing sewer and making improvements within the sewer overflow. The project will take 22 weeks to complete and the works have been split into three areas, as shown below:

Plan of Works

Area A - Wood Vue

This part of the works will involve the installation of pipework and manholes to replace the sewer in Wood Vue, creating additional capacity within the sewer network. During this work, short sections of the road will be closed, known as a rolling road closure.

Area B - Cow Plantation

This part of the works will involve modification to the existing sewer overflow. Our modifications will reduce pollution to the environment.

Area C - Site Compound

This area will be used to undertake the administration of the project, along with the temporary storage for the site.
