

SPRINGWELL ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT UPDATE

Reservoir Construction

This £53m project will directly supply clean, clear and great tasting water to more than 50,000 customers in South Tyneside and improve the resilience of water supplies across Wearside and South Tyneside.

Since we mobilised to site in May 2023 good progress has been made.

The construction programme is 40% complete, and a lot has happened over the last year: we've removed 60,000 cubic metres of excavated material, and 50% of the reservoir construction is complete.

5.5km Pipeline

The second phase includes the construction of a 5.5km pipeline, which will link the reservoir to existing water mains serving customers east of Usworth in Washington.
